

### DID YOU KNOW?

We provide a number of tools and helps to assist our members and others to grow in an understanding of God’s word. **Did you know** that we record the Sunday a.m. and p.m. sermons and Sunday morning and Wednesday night auditorium Bible lessons? **Did you know** that you can listen to them anywhere in the world on your digital devices over the internet? You can **hear them** through the Nashville Road Church of Christ website. The website address is [www.nashvilleroad.org](http://www.nashvilleroad.org). When you click on the web address or copy and paste, you will arrive at the HOME page. Click on the bar button that says “SERMONS.” You will find on that page the list of **Sermons and Bible classes** that were recorded and the dates they were recorded. Click on the one you want to hear and it will play on your digital device.

**Did you know** that those of you who are not able to attend can not only hear the auditorium **Bible studies** but you can also download the study materials for those classes. For instance, go to my personal website [www.biblestudyplus.info](http://www.biblestudyplus.info). There you will find three ways to make the material available for the Wednesday night study on Daniel. When you arrive at the home page, click on the pull down tab “Old Testament” and then click on “Daniel.” The material will appear as a pdf file. You can then download and print the material for yourself. **IT’S FREE!** You can also type in “Daniel” in the **search window** at the top of the home page, and it will take you to the material and display the charts. You can also scroll down the home page until you see the Book of Daniel title page. Click on it and the material will appear for study and/or printing.

**Did you know** that I have added six more Bible outlines for study on my personal website? They are **Jeremiah, Ezra, Nehemiah, Esther, and 1 & 2 Corinthians**. Although we do not record the Ladies Bible Class lessons, the material for the books we have studied are available, which include **Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy, Joshua, Judges, Ruth, 1 & 2 Samuel, 1 Kings, Job, and Isaiah** and the new ones listed above.
