**(2 Timothy 1:7)**

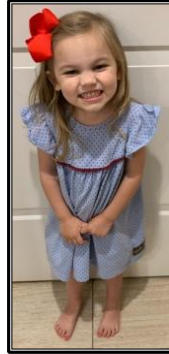
